TO: Parents of Students; Kindergarten – 4th Grade

Congratulations, as your child finishes his/her school year. We hope that you and your child are looking forward to your next grade level experience. Meal prices at the elementary school for the School Year 2011-2012 are as follows:

Breakfast: \$1.00

Lunch: \$2.05

We would like to remind you that, **any balance on your child's school meal account at the end of this year will carry over to his/her school meal account on the first day of school in August.** It does not matter if your child will be attending a different elementary school. The account balance will follow them wherever they go. **To repeat, if you owe money on your child's meal account at the end of this school year, that amount will show up on their meal account on the very first day of school. Please check your child's account balance now and make arrangements to pay it in full by the end of this school year. Furthermore, no a la carte sales will be allowed if a student has a negative balance.** Please also note that if your child has a **positive balance**, that amount will carry over to next year as well.

As always, it is best to pre-pay your child's meals on a weekly or monthly basis. Cafeteria personnel are available in the mornings before and during breakfast to receive money for your child's account. Especially in today's economy, we strongly encourage you to complete an application for Free or reduced price meals at the beginning of the school year. .
